## THE CHINESE AND JAPANESE PROGRAMS AT PURDUE

The Chinese and Japanese section of the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures offers courses leading to minors in Chinese and Japanese, a major in Japanese, and an MA in Japanese pedagogy. They include subjects ranging from elementary level language courses to graduate level courses in literature, linguistics, and second language acquisition. There are opportunities for study abroad.
