

## Checklist for Students in Health & Safety Education or Physical Education

### GATE A Requirements (*application required*)

- \_\_\_\_\_ **Complete BLOCK I courses (EDCI 205, 285)**  
*(no grade lower than a "C", must have 3.0 in professional education classes)*
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Pass PPST** *(registration info in wall racks outside OPPL office, BRNG 3229)*  
Required Scores
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Reading = 176 or above
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Writing = 172 or above
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Math = 175 or above
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Meet GPA Standards**
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Overall GPA at 2.50 or above
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Content GPA at 2.75 or above *(no grade lower than a "C" in all dept. courses)*
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Professional Education GPA at 3.0 or above *(no grade lower than a "C")*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Meet satisfactory assessment of the initial portfolio (through Block I).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submit a signed Signature form to OPPL *(Download form from above web site.)*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Submit a teacher education application to OPPL Office in BRNG 3229  
*Download form from above web site.*  
*Application deadline is last day of classes each semester.*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Receive written notification of status through GATE A from OPPL.

**Must pass through Gate A before taking Block II courses (EDPS 235 and 265), HK 319, or HK 330.**

*HK 319 and HK 330 are usually taken Spring semester of the Junior Year.*

*If not eligible for these courses at that time, your plan of study will generally be set back one full year.*

### GATE B Requirements (*no application required*)

- \_\_\_\_\_ Complete BLOCK II courses (EDPS 235, 265)  
*(no grade lower than a "C", must have 3.0 in professional ed classes)*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Maintain GPA standards listed above.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Meet satisfactory assessment of the beginning portfolio (through Block II).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Receive written notification of status through GATE B from OPPL.

**Must pass through Gate B before taking Methods courses, EDCI 429 (PE) and EDCI 432 (H&S).**

*EDCI 429 and 432 are usually only offered during the fall semester of the Senior Year.*

*If not eligible for these courses at that time, your plan of study will generally be set back one full year.*

### GATE C Requirements (*no application required*)

- \_\_\_\_\_ Contact the Office of Field Experiences (BRNG 3241) in the fall of the academic year preceding the student teaching semester (i.e. junior year) to receive an access code and password in order to complete the online Student Teaching Application.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Maintain GPA standards listed above.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Meet satisfactory assessment of the developing portfolio as defined by faculty.
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Pass PRAXIS II: Subject Assessments/Speciality Areas Tests.**
- \_\_\_\_\_ Receive written notification of status through GATE C from OPPL.

**Must pass through Gate C before Student Teaching.**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Begin job search through the Center for Career Opportunities.

### GATE D Requirements (*License application is required*)

- \_\_\_\_\_ Student teach through the Office of Field Experiences.  
*All professional education courses must be completed before student teaching.*
- \_\_\_\_\_ A grade of "C" or above must be earned in EDCI 498 (Supervised Teaching).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Maintain GPA standards listed above and criteria for Gates A, B, and C.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Receive degree. (Required for recommendation for licensure.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Apply for Indiana Teaching License through OPPL.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Apply for licensure in other states, if desired.
