The annual CLA Honors Colloquium showcases the best undergraduate coursework of the year. Selected students present papers or posters of their work, build their resumes, and have a chance to win cash prizes. (The poster session will include the display and discussion of 2-D posters, as well as the display of original artwork, installations, or experimental models.)

Eligible work includes:

1. Coursework from any CLA Honors or UHP 2009 course (Spring or Fall semesters).
2. Work completed in any 2009 course by a CLA Honors student with 9 or more honors credits.

All sorts of work will be considered, from academic papers to experimental models or creative work. We seek a range of work from across the disciplines of CLA.

Application Instructions

A complete application consists of three things:

1. The completed application form (p. 2 of this document)
2. A copy of the work being submitted:
 - a. If you are applying to give a paper or reading at the colloquium, please submit the paper (or other written work) itself.
 - b. If you are applying to take part in the poster session, please submit a written description of the project, plus supporting graphics (e.g. photographs or video).
Please to do not submit original work at the application stage.
3. A one-paragraph abstract of the project, to be used in the Colloquium brochure if your project is selected.
