Eligibility to Enroll in an Honors Course:

Beginning students: SAT combined of 1800, **or** ACT composite of 26, **or** top 10% of high school class.

New transfer students: Bring copy of transcript to the Honors office (BRNG 1172) for evaluation.

Continuing students: Cumulative GPA of 3.0/4.0 or better.

- Eligible students may choose to take only a few honors courses or may complete the program requirements listed below.
- Each completed Honors course is notated as "Honors" on the academic transcript.

Requirements for Graduation with College of Liberal Arts Honors:

Note: Students must apply to the CLA Honors Program to be eligible for Honors Scholarships and other benefits.

- Apply to the CLA Honors Program at any time *after* completing one semester at Purdue.
- Maintain an overall GPA of **3.3/4.0** or better.
- Complete 24 credit hours of Honors with a B or better in each course following the distribution below.
 - *Any course at the 50000-level or above will automatically count as Honors.*
 - *If a student has more than one major, only one major is chosen for the distribution below.*
 - *All University Honors courses (HONR) apply to CLA Honors, as does any course at Purdue that has "Honors" as a part of the course title.*
 - *If students study abroad for one full year, they need to complete only 21 credits of Honors coursework.*
- Students who are accepted to the program and complete all of the requirements below will earn the notation "College of Liberal Arts Honors Program" on their academic transcripts.
