PREREQUISITE: Students must complete PSY 12000 (minimum grade of C-) and achieve a GPA of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale in the three Pre-PSY (Area A) courses and in PSY 12000 before declaring this or any concentration or major in psychology.

**PSY 12000 and Pre-PSY courses may only be taken twice for admission purposes.** Withdrawals with a grade of “W” do not count as an attempt; withdrawals with a grade of WF do count as an attempt.
