Proficiency may be established by taking and passing FR 20200, by examination, or by other evidence acceptable to the department. In addition, FLL 26100 or the equivalent (ENGL/AUSL 22700) is a prerequisite for FR 36100/56100/36200/56200.

Effective Fall 2000, Students must achieve a minimum grade of "C" in each course used for the French major. A minimum GPA of "B-" (2.67/4) in the major is ALSO required for the student to graduate with a French major.
