

Before undertaking this major, the student must establish proficiency equivalent to French Level IV. Proficiency may be established by taking and passing FR 20200, by examination, or by other evidence acceptable to the Department. In addition FLL 26100 or the equivalent ENGL/SLHS 22700 is a prerequisite for FR 36100,36200,56100, and 56200.

**A minimum grade of “C” is required for a course to count for the major. A minimum GPA of “B-” (2.67/4) in the major is required for the student to graduate with a French-Secondary Education major.**
