(M)WOST

The requirements for the minor include IDIS 28000, Introduction to Women’s Studies, and four additional courses. The introductory course provides an overview of this interdisciplinary area of study. **One additional Women’s Studies IDIS course is required at the 40000 level.** The remaining three courses are selected from a list of approved courses offered by departments and programs in the School of Liberal Arts. Some of these courses have departmental prerequisites. Although IDIS 28000 is not a prerequisite to any of them, it is recommended as the first course of the program.
