All undergraduates and graduate students are eligible to apply for two grants of \$250 to be used toward funding a presentation at a national or international conference.

Deadline: DECEMBER 1, 2009

Application Process: Please submit the following materials to the IDIS office (Classical Studies Program) in Beering Hall 1289, by December 1, addressed to: Delayne Graham, Administrative Head, IDIS Office

- ♦ A one-page version of your cv, including any other conference presentations;
- ♦ A personal statement of roughly 300 words sketching the importance of this presentation to your coursework and main area of research;
- ♦ A sample of your critical writing (between 5 and 20 pages in length), or a copy of the paper itself if it has already been presented;
- ♦ A preliminary or final budget (if the trip has already been completed), that includes conference dates and all estimated travel, accommodation, registration, limo (including taxi or shuttle), parking, and food costs.

Winners will be recognized at the IDIS Recognition Day in April.

Winners will be notified in advance of the April 2010 IDIS Recognition Day.
