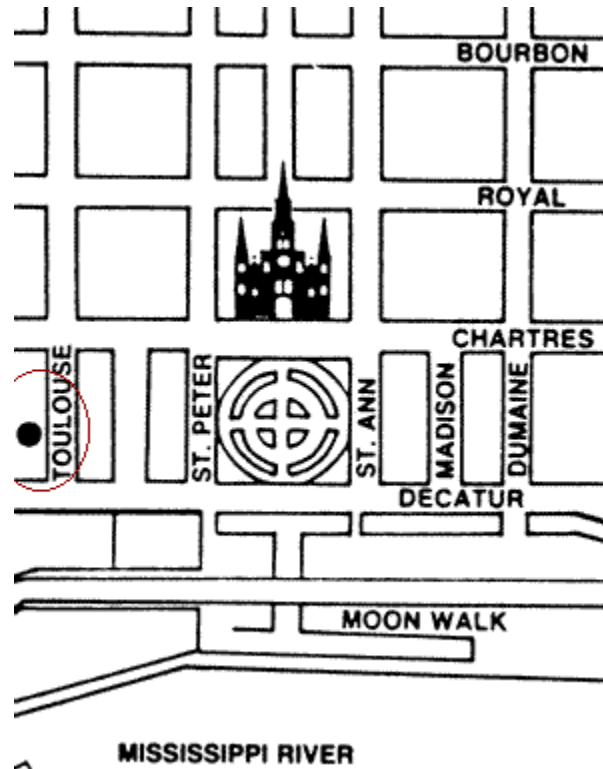


Thursday Events at KBS 2002

O'Flaherty's Irish Channel Pub
514 Toulouse St. (French Quarter)

Directions to O'Flaherty's: O'Flaherty's is just two blocks south of Royal St (Holiday-Inn) and four blocks south of Dauphine St. (Chateau LeMoynes). It is ½ block from Jax Brewery (Decatur St), and 2 blocks from Jackson Square in the heart of the French Quarter. Registration is in Tara's Courtyard at the center of the O'Flaherty's complex. The main events are in the Ballad Room, which is to the right of the carriage way as you enter O'Flaherty's.

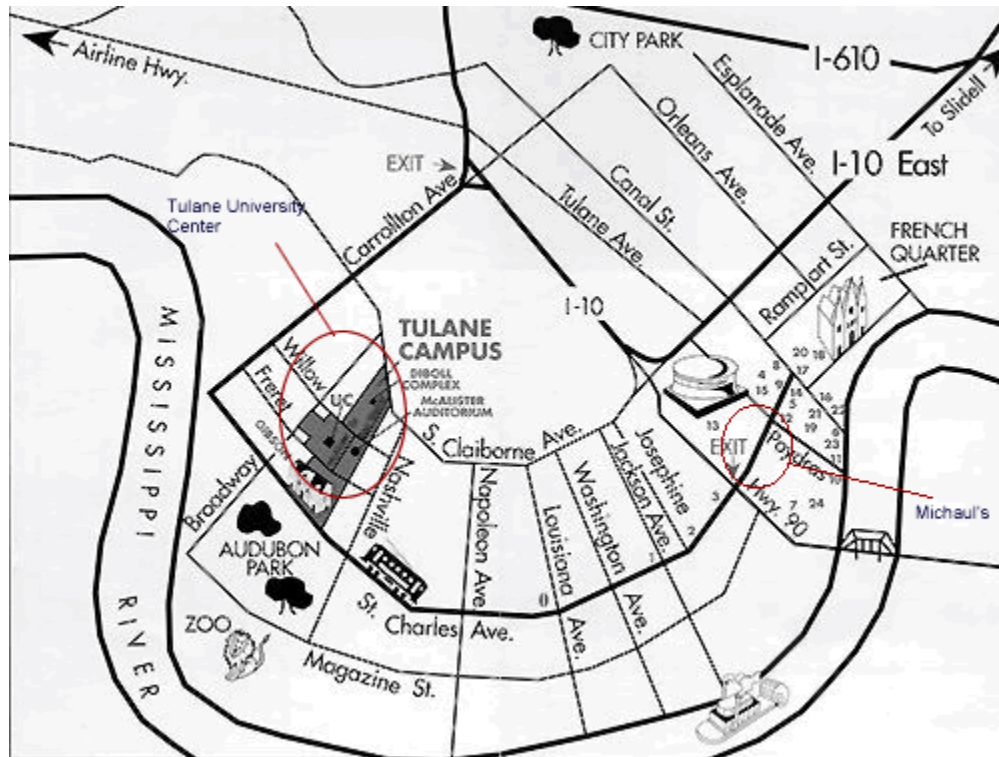
Friday and Saturday Events at KBS 2002

Events at Tulane on both days begin with sessions at 8:30 a.m., with events there running until 5:30 p.m.

Directions to Tulane University Center: The Tulane campus is located in Uptown New Orleans on the St. Charles Avenue Streetcar line, approximately four miles from the French Quarter. The streetcars run twenty-four hours a day and stop immediately in front of the Admission Office. The fare is \$1.25 (exact change required). It's possible to purchase a 3-day pass for buses and streetcars for \$12.00. (See RTA's website at <http://www.regionaltransit.org/mainpage.html> for more information.)

The Tulane University Center is on McAlister Drive, about 1/4 block from Freret St. It is in the middle of campus. From the streetcar line drop-off, the walk is about three-tenths of a mile across campus to Freret St., crossing Freret and walking past the Fogelman Gym to the University Center.
