Membership Application

The Purdue chapter of PI DELTA PHI, the national French honor society, will initiate new members on April 7, 2001. If you meet the eligibility criteria listed below and wish to be nominated for membership, complete this form and return it to the department receptionist in Stanley Coulter Room 120. It will be forwarded to the faculty sponsor, Professor Deborah Schocket. **The due date is Wednesday March 7, 2001.**

Eligibility

1. Completion of two French courses (3 credits each) beyond FR 202 at Purdue. These courses may include French 241, 261, 301, 302, 360, 380, 401, 402, 424, or others.
2. A grade-point average of no less than 3.0 (B) in all French courses at Purdue, and a cumulative index of B- in all courses at Purdue. For undergraduates, both averages should be based on at least two semesters of college work.
3. Graduate students in French who have a 3.0 (B) average in two advanced courses in French are also eligible.
4. An undergraduate student may be admitted to active membership while still enrolled in the second course in French beyond French 202, provided the instructor of that course is willing to recommend the student's work as being B quality or better.

Membership

The one-time dues assessment is \$25. *Your check payable to PI DELTA PHI must accompany this application.* These fees will be returned to the student if the application does not meet eligibility requirements. On the national level, the society promotes annual scholarship competition for the French Government Scholarship, the Pi Delta Phi Scholarship and the Louis E. Richter Award. On the local level, chapters develop and sponsor activities which will promote interest in French culture, either in the academic milieu or in the community.
