Course Description

The <u>principal goal</u> of this course is the development of your Italian language skills through integrated use of topics in culture, grammar and vocabulary. This is an <u>intensive-accelerated</u> language course held entirely in Italian, including grammar explanations, assignments and exam directions. By reading and viewing authentic texts you will complement the language instruction to accelerate you learning of Italian in all its aspects; you will also be able to make comparisons at the basic level with your own culture. You will write different kinds of texts in Italian, including in the electronic format. The general focus of the lessons will be to practice the topics and grammatical points presented in the textbook. The <u>implicit goal</u> of this course is to give you the tools to communicate in Italian at the basic level and to understand different kinds of audio, video and written texts that you will naturally be exposed to during travel or study in Italy.
