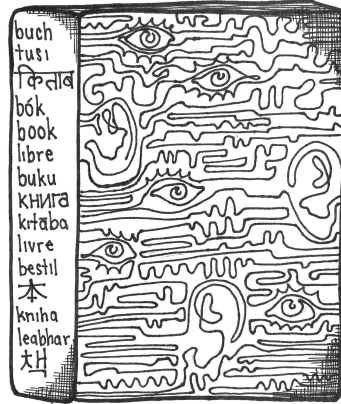


Cornerstone Spring 2021 Contest “The Book”

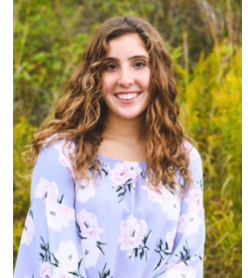
