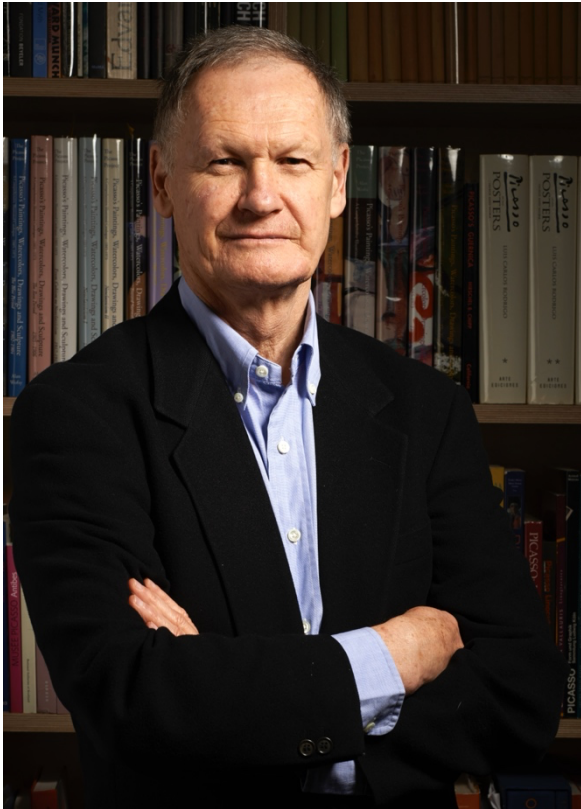


The Cornerstone Integrated Liberal Arts Program presents:

In Conversation with Frederick Mulder, PhD, LLD, CBE Art Dealer and Charity Founder



Born to a humble farming family on the Canadian prairies, Dr. Mulder rose to become a fixture of the international art dealing scene for over half a century, selling works from artists such as Picasso, Munch, Dürer, and Rembrandt to a client list that includes top museums, celebrities, and high-net-worth individuals. He is a leading expert in the field of 19th and 20th century European prints, especially Picasso. Besides founding and running his art business, he founded a crowd-funding charity called The Funding Network which has raised over \$20 million worldwide in fourteen countries. That has led to his being named one of "Britain's leading philanthropists" by *The Independent* and receiving a CBE honor from Queen Elizabeth II.
