Required Documents:

- Theatrical resume; must include one faculty or one staff or one graduate TA in the Theatre
 Department, who has indicated a willingness to speak to the Scholarship Committee regarding
 your application.
- A statement discussing how you have contributed to the Department of Theatre in class and in productions, as well as short-term and long-term goals.
- CODO (Change of Degree Option) students must have submitted the CODO paperwork; scholarship award is contingent on completion of the CODO process and listing as a Theatre major.
