

## **Confucius Institute Scholarships and HSK**

### **Scholarships 奖学金**

Confucius Institute at Purdue University (CIP) encourages and helps Purdue students apply for the Confucius Institute Scholarships for language study in its partner institution— Shanghai Jiaotong University for one academic year or one semester. Direct CHNS course credit transfer to Purdue is available. Scholarships are available every year and application starts in February. Scholarship winners will be waived fees for registration, tuition, basic learning materials, campus accommodation, outpatient medical service and comprehensive insurance for international students while studying in China. In addition, they will receive a one-time subsidy (CNY 1,500/one academic year, CNY 1,000/one semester) and monthly living allowance (CNY 1400/month).

### **HSK (Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi 汉语水平考试)**

### **HSKK (Hanyu Shuiping Kouyu Kaoshi 汉语水平口语考试)**

Applicants for one-academic year scholarship should achieve a score of at least 180 points on HSK (Level 3) and at least 60 points on HSKK (Elementary Level). Applicants for one semester scholarship should achieve a score of at least 120 points on HSK (Level 2) and at least 40 points on HSKK (Elementary Level). HSK scores are globally accepted as proof of Chinese proficiency levels. HSK and HSKK are fee-based. Refer to the next page for fee table and payment method.

### **Purdue HSK Testing Center**

CIP is now an authorized testing center by Confucius Institute Headquarters. The next HSK and HSKK test will take place on Saturday, March 28, 2015. Application deadline is March 18, 2015. Test result will be provided to the test takers by HSK testing center either on-line or by postal mails.
