The AFF awards scholarships ranging from \$500 - \$1,000 for study abroad in a Francophone country. Qualified students may participate in a year-long, semester or spring break program. Only candidates accepted for a study abroad program recognized by Purdue University and located in a French-speaking country may be considered for an AFF award.

The application should include: 1) this form; 2) a one-page essay written in French explaining why you wish to study abroad, how the experience will contribute to your professional and personal development, and why the AFF scholarship would be particularly valuable to you; 3) a copy of their acceptance letter from the Study Abroad Office; 4) a current transcript; and 5) two sealed and signed letters of recommendation, at least one from a French instructor they have had at Purdue University, if possible. Purdue instructors may also submit their letters by e-mail.
