- A one-three page project proposal describing the work to be undertaken in Rome and its significance to your artistic and/or scholarly career. Please note any particular resources that may be available in the region that could contribute to your work.
- A portfolio that will speak to your artistic or scholarly ability to accomplish the task outlined in the proposal.

Department of Theatre

- Current Curriculum Vitae or Form 36
- A one-three page project proposal describing the work to be undertaken in Rome and its significance to your artistic and or scholarly career. Please note any particular resources that may be available in the region that could contribute to your work.

- A portfolio, DVD or other materials that speak to your ability to do the work outlined in the proposal

Division of Dance

- Current Curriculum Vitae or Form 36
- A one-three page project proposal describing the work to be undertaken in Rome and its significance to your artistic and or scholarly career. Please note any particular resources that may be available in the region that could contribute to your work.
- A DVD or other materials that speak to your ability to do the work outlined in the proposal.

Division of Music

- Current Curriculum Vitae or Form 36

- CDs, DVDs or other performance, scholarly or compositional materials that speak to your ability to do the work outlined in the proposal.

The Fellow, upon return, will present to the faculty and students of the Patti and Rusty Rueff School of Visual and Performing Arts a lecture, performance or presentation of accomplishments made during their stay at the Academy. This reception/presentation should be held sometime during the academic year following their return from Rome.
