

Announcing the 2020 American Studies
Excellence in Teaching Award

You are invited to nominate an American Studies student for the 2020 American Studies Excellence in Teaching Award. The Award will go to a student who demonstrates an outstanding, innovative record of teaching. The Award will be determined by a Committee of AMST faculty. The Award comes with a \$100.00 stipend from the American Studies program.

Students may be nominated or self-nominate for the Award. To be eligible, a student must be employed in at least two consecutive semester of teaching concurrent with and prior to the semester in which the Award is received. Nominees for the Award must be enrolled in the American Studies Program at Purdue and be in good standing.

Nominations include a letter explaining the nomination, the student's CV, and evidence of instructional excellence, which might include student evaluations from the two most recent complete consecutive semesters of teaching, and a letter of recommendation from one faculty member familiar or any other appropriate documentation.
